

Getting to Lannion

BY PLANE

you will have to transit through PARIS.

There are two main airports: PARIS CHARLES DE GAULLE (CDG) or PARIS ORLY

You can also take an internal flight from PARIS to BREST airport. Note that **Brest is about 100 km away** from Lannion. You will need to get a train from BREST station to Lannion. A shuttle connects the airport to the tram station at Porte de Guipavas.

RENNES Airport <https://www.rennes.aeroport.fr/en> if you choose to reach Rennes. Make sure you have **enough time** to reach the train station. The SNCF stop is a 15-minutes' walk from the airport (the train ticket for a one-way ticket is ~ 2 €.)

BY TRAIN

→ FROM PARIS-CHARLES DE GAULLE

If you have landed at PARIS CDG airport. You can complete your journey by train. Roissy's railway station is near Terminal 2. You just have to follow the direction TGV (high speed train) There is a direct train from Roissy to Rennes and from Rennes you can catch another train to Lannion.

If the timetables of this direct line do not suit you, you should go to the train station located in the city center of Paris "Montparnasse".

Take the RER B to Denfert-Rochereau. From there, you will then need to take metro line 4 (towards 'Porte de Clignancourt') or 6 (towards 'Etoile') to get to the Gare Montparnasse. The journey takes around 50 minutes. RER tickets cost about 11 € and metro tickets 1,90 €. For information on the metro timetables and for a map of the Paris metro, consult this website:

There is also a direct shuttle to Montparnasse station. Line 4. Lebusdirect the journey takes about 70 mn (depending on the traffic) and costs about 18€: <https://www.lebusdirect.com/en/lines-and-schedules/cdg-airport-paris-gare-montparnasse-line.html>

→ FROM PARIS-ORLY

If you have landed at Orly airport, there is no direct train so you should go to Montparnasse station. You can use the Orlybus shuttle service or the Orlyval automatic metro to reach "Denfert-Rochereau station and then take metro line 4 or 6 (see details

You can always take a **Taxi** from the airport to Montparnasse station. It will cost you around 60 €

FROM PARIS TO LANNION BY TRAIN

From Montparnasse station there are some high speed trains (TGV) each day. You can buy your ticket online which is usually cheaper but they are non-refundable most of the time. To check the timetables, consult SNCF's website: <https://en.oui.sncf/en/>
